## Western Region Training Requirements

Prior to participating in studies involving patients, strict training requirements must be met. The following is a list of three trainings required by the Western Region of the National Dental Practice-Based Research Network. You may complete these trainings now to be prepared for your first Network Study.

### Orientation Training – *one time only*

- This is a 15-minute video that will give you the basic research tools you need to participate in National Network Studies. To complete the training:

- This 30-40-minute training reviews the laws and regulations for anyone conducting research.
